If you have children already attending the Two Way Immersion, Rosedale is considered your neighborhood school. Registration for the 2017-2018 school year will be Wednesday December 7, 2016 in the Rosedale Computer Lab Room 12 from 8:30 - 2:30. If you are not currently part of our Rosedale family you will need to register at your neighborhood school.

Registration for the 2017 school year will be held beginning the week of December 7, 2015. To enter school in the fall, a child must be five years old on or before September 1, 2017. to enter Transitional Kindergarten, a child must turn five between September 2, 2017 and December 2, 2017. Parents should register their children with the school serving their residence area. Proof of residence is required. Click here to access our online school locator program. Parents can input their address and find out their resident school

Rosedale will be doing our registration on-line using the <u>online registration</u>. Your registration will not be complete without the required documents. If you do not provide the required documents we will not hold a spot for you.

The following are required to register a child: (1) proof of date of birth is required (birth certificate, baptismal certificate, or other legal proof), (2) two forms verifying proof of residency, and (3) written immunization record from a physician, nurse, or health department. Children must be immunized for MMR - measles, mumps and rubella (German measles), polio, DTaP - diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis (whooping cough), Hepatitis B, and Varicella (chicken pox) prior to school entry. A temporary or permanent medical exemption to one or more of the immunizations may be granted under certain circumstances if a licensed physician provides documentation.
